College/Career Readiness Checklists

11th Grade

- Keep grades up all year long. This is your final year to show college admissions counselors what you're made of. When you apply to college next year, admissions teams will see a transcript including grades from 9th - 11th.
- Continue attending local college fairs.
- Begin in earnest to investigate college scholarship/financial aid opportunities – apply when appropriate.
- Research College Board Big Future to learn more about colleges in our area, the state, and/or out-of-state.
- Continue investigating career options and college majors. Take personal aptitude tests for a thorough examination of your God-given talents and career interests.
- Continue participation and leadership roles in various school, church, and community organizations.
- Take the PSAT again in the fall to become eligible for The National Merit Scholarship Competition and to get a true measure of where you might score on the SAT and ACT.
- Create a resume. Do not be humble on your resume...this is the time to shine.
- Begin college visits. You need to get your feet on college campuses to know if you picture yourself there.
- Take the SAT or ACT in the **winter** of this year. Follow in late spring/early summer with another SAT or an ACT.
- Register with the NCAA Initial Eligibility if you plan to play sports in college. Transcripts will be uploaded by your counselor in the summer after your junior year.
- Keep your social media clean and respectful. You represent your God, your family, and your school.
