ADMISSION INFORMATION

As a religious institution, established by Lee Park Church seeking to provide an education infused with a Biblical Worldview, admission is by invitation. LPP reserves the privilege of setting and maintaining admissions standards. Student conduct, academics, pastoral recommendation, church membership, family interview, and student statement of faith are considerations for admission. We expect all families to affirm the Bible is the inspired Word of God and the absolute truth by which Christians live. Enrollment is a privilege, not a right.

ACADEMICS

AP courses (6 authorized), Dual Enrollment, and Honors courses are available. Students must meet placement criteria and have a teacher recommendation to participate in a program. LPP does not rank students. The grade point average is based on a 4.0 scale. Honors weighted courses add .5 to the GPA calculation. AP weighted courses add 1.0 to the GPA calculation.
